Radioactive Iodine Total Body Scan and Thyroglobulin Blood Test using Thyrogen Protocol

Dr. Drucker has prescribed Thyrogen for you. You will need to fill this prescription at the Toronto General Pharmacy. If you wish to fill the prescription at your local pharmacy, please note not all pharmacies stock Thyrogen and may require 4-5 days to order for you.

Thyrogen must be refrigerated; it is recommended that you pick up your Thyrogen the day of or day prior to your scan.

Arrangements have been made to have the injections of Thyrogen on Monday and Tuesday at the Toronto General Hospital (TGH), Nuclear Medicine Department. On Wednesday you will go to the Nuclear Medicine Department at TGH for your Radioactive Iodine Capsule (5mCi). On Friday you will return to TGH Nuclear Medicine for the Whole Body Scan and Thyroglobulin Blood Test.
